Directions to the Nation Guard Armory - 711 Hillcrest Avenue, Benicia CA

From 680 Freeway Take 780 Freeway west toward Benicia/Vallejo From 80 Freeway Take 780 Freeway east toward Benicia/Martinez

From the 780 Freeway

Take the East 5th Street exit, turn north onto 5th Street at the end of the off-ramp and go under the freeway (if exiting from 780 East). 5th Street ends at Hillcrest Ave. Turn right onto Hillcrest Ave. The Armory is at the end of the road on the left.

Directions to the Holiday Parade staging are on 2nd and 'D' Street

From 780 Freeway take the 2^{nd} Street exit.

Turn left onto 2nd Street at the end of the off-ramp.

Turn right on Military Street West, then turn left on 1st Street.

Continue on 1st Street or jog over to 2nd Street to park.

The parade runs north up 1^{st} Street, so it's best to park above 'H' Street to return to your car.

Meet at 9:00 am
