VIA THE GOLDEN GATE BRIDGE:

After the Toll Plaza, follow the signs to MARINA BLVD/PRESIDIO. After the first tunnel, merge to the right lanes and take the MARINA BLVD. exit in the second tunnel. At the bottom of the exit, turn LEFT onto GIRARD which becomes Marina Blvd. Stay on Marina until it ends in a sharp right turn just past Safeway and becomes LAGUNA (Fort Mason's Great Meadow will be on your left). At the next signal turn LEFT onto BAY ST. After ${}^{3}/_{10}$ mile, take the first LEFT into FORT MASON at FRANKLIN STREET. (Follow Site Directions below.)

VIA HWY. 280 NORTH to SAN FRANCISCO:


Follow 280 NORTH and exit on the left onto US-101 NORTH toward SAN FRANCISCO CIVIC CENTER/BAY BRIDGE. Stay in the right lane to continue on 101 NORTH at the US-101/US-80 split. After the split, take the NINTH STREET/CIVIC CENTER exit, and follow the Via the Bay Bridge directions below.

VIA THE BAY BRIDGE:

Once over the bridge, follow signs to NINTH STREET/CIVIC CENTER exit. On the exit ramp, stay in the right two lanes, continuing through the signal (a slight left turn) and turn RIGHT at the next signal onto NINTH STREET. Staying in the left two lanes, continue on NINTH for ½ mile until the lanes merge left onto HAYES STREET. Go 3 blocks on Hayes and turn RIGHT onto FRANKLIN STREET. Franklin will take you directly to FORT MASON.

SITE DIRECTIONS:

Follow FRANKLIN into Fort Mason, past the first stop sign & to the right of the middle divider. Turn LEFT onto FUNSTON. Funston ends at the site, which is the shady lawn area in front of the AYHA YOUTH HOSTEL. **Unloading Only in front of the Hostel - NO PARKING!** See the map below for parking areas.



Swiss Dog Day Afternoon 2017 AKC Community Canine Test (CGCA) AKC Canine Good Citizen Test (CGC)

- Dogs passing these tests will earn AKC certification (CGC or CGCA).
- To take the Community Canine (CGCA) test, dogs must have passed a Canine Good Citizen (CGC) test that is on record with the AKC.
- A maximum of 12 dogs will be tested. No minimum age limit for entry.
- Dog must wear a well fitted buckle or slip collar made of leather, fabric, or chain – no training collars (prong, head halters, etc.)
- You need to bring: Your own grooming brush and a 4 to 6 ft. leash
